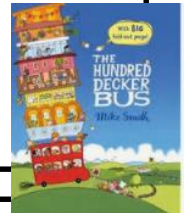
## Summer term Let's Go Outside

**Maths**- We will be looking at number and place value to 20, counting on and back from a given number within 20. We will start to look at halving, doubling and sharing. We will look at measure and also explore patterns.
