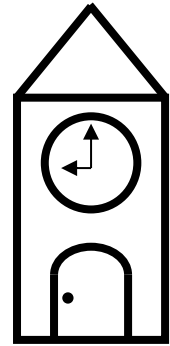

Physical Education

As the weather brightens, we are hoping to be able to get out on the field more regularly to partake in sporting activities. Class teachers will have made you aware of the timetabled dates for PE lessons, however, we advise that children have their PE kits in school each day should changes be made to timetable or different activities planned. Ideally, the school kit for PE lessons and all after school sports clubs should include the following:

- T-shirt (white) - sleeveless vests or crop tops are not appropriate
- Shorts (blue or black)
- Leggings or jogging bottoms (blue or black)
- Jumper/Fleece/Hoodie (blue or black)
- Suitable trainers and/or plimsolls

We take our health and safety advice from Cambridgeshire County Council guidance. Children are not allowed to wear any jewellery during sporting activities, this includes stud earrings. We cannot tape up any pierced ears, therefore children need to be able to remove their studs themselves or take them out before coming to school. Long hair will also need to be tied back.

PE is an important part of the National Curriculum and is also integral to our PSHE and healthy living curriculum. Therefore, if for any reason your child cannot partake in PE, please make the class teacher or a member of the office staff aware in advance.
