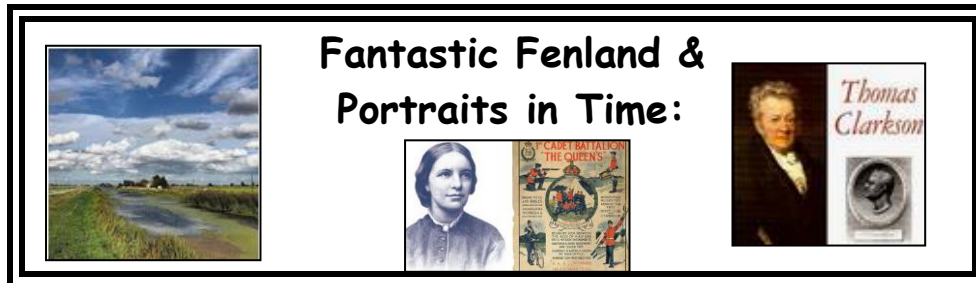

This religion has a rich and wonderful history!



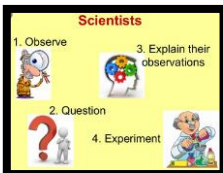
Art - Portraits: Sketching and painting.

Place Value
