Hooray - Let's go on Holiday!!!



This topic looks at how holidays are an important aspect of family life and also how these have changed throughout history. Children will make comparisons between holidays in the past and now. They will begin to understand how the evolution of transportation has impacted upon holidays today too!

PSHE - we will explore the difference between to need and to want; and we will think about the skills we might need for different jobs.



RE - Sikhism:

We will learn what Sikhs believe about God and how the world was created; the sikh celebrations and ceremonies including the Gurdwara; and the Sikh way of life.



Art - Nature: We will celebrate the wonders of nature and explore art in our natural world by experimenting with texture and form and identifying patterns.

DT - Food and Nutrition: We will learn how to prepare meals which are healthy and meet requirements of the different food groups taking into account who their target diners are.



Music - Musical Pictures:

We will perform, listen to, review and evaluate music across a range of historical periods, genres, styles and traditions, including the works of the great composers and musicians.

Science - Plants:

We will observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. And find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.



Computing - Our themes will be: spreadsheets and coding.

PE - we will be improving skills looked at throughout the year with an extra oomph in running, throwing and jumping!

Maths -

This next term, as well as revisiting the four operations, we will be exploring graphs, time and fractions.



English -

Read Write Inc. Phonics

Alongside our daily Read Write Inc. sessions, we shall be reading different types of text.

This term, these will be: **Traditional tales from other cultures**

Writing letters and postcards

Nonsense poetry

We will read and explore each genre and then use them as inspiration to write our own creative responses.

We will be trying really hard to think of our own ideas, form our letters correctly, and remember capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

Using descriptive words and extending sentences with but, so, then, because, if and then independently, will be our ultimate goals.
